

Whippoorwill Club Dress Policy

Shoes

- Athletic footwear/sneakers and flip-flops are prohibited in the clubhouse and patio. Athletic footwear/sneakers are defined as shoes to be worn when working out or participating in physical activity. Also, shoes with large, recognizable logos (i.e., Nike Swoosh, Adidas Stripes, etc.) are not allowed.
- Casual or “dress” sneakers (e.g., Allbirds) free of recognizable logos are permitted.
- Golf Shoes and racquet sport sneakers are permitted in the Grille Room, Banks Bar, and Patio when wearing golf or racquet attire.

Denim

- Denim is allowed in the Grille Room, Banks Bar, and Patio for lunch every day and for dinner on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Sunday. Denim is not permitted in the clubhouse after 3pm on Saturdays.
- Denim is never allowed in the Calder Dining Room.
- Denim must be free of holes, tears, and fraying of any kind.
- Women are allowed to wear white or black denim at all times.

Shirts

- Shirts must be collared and tucked in at all times. Shirts designed to be worn untucked are acceptable.
- T-shirts, hooded shirts, and hooded sweatshirts are not allowed.
- Sports uniforms, swim attire, and exercise wear are not allowed in the clubhouse or patio.

Hats

- Men must remove hats when in the clubhouse, and while dining on the patio.
- Men are allowed to wear hats in the golf shop and locker room.
- Women are allowed to wear hats in the clubhouse until 6 PM and at all times on the patio.
- Women’s fashionable hats are permitted at all times.

Dress Code Categories for Specific Club Events

Formal Attire includes dress pants and jackets for men, dresses, skirts of modest length, and dress pants for women. Golf shoes and athletic sneakers are not permitted.

Country Club Attire includes tucked-in, collared shirts (unless it is designed to be worn untucked), turtlenecks, neat pants, and golf-length shorts for men; pants, black/white denim, skirts, golf-length shorts and shirts that may be collared or not for women.
